Lieutenant -General Georgi Vazov is one of the most glorious generals in the history of the Bulgarian army.

In 1913, during the Balkan War, he led the advance of Allied troops in the eastern sector and participated in the capture of the first forts of Edirne - Ayvazbaba and Aydjioolu and in the capture of Shukri Pasha.

Lieutenant -General Georgi Vazov was Minister of Defense from June 28, 1913 to August 22, 1913

His brother, Major- General Vladimir Vazov, also participated in the Balkan wars.
